



### **COMMERCIAL RECYCLING:**

The Borough of Mount Penn Ordinance #615, amended by Ordinance #794 requires a mandatory recycling program throughout the Borough. The Borough has established recycling requirements for all properties in the Borough of Mount Penn. It shall be the duty of every property owner in the Borough wherein recyclables are generated and/or accumulated to provide for the collection, removal, and disposal of such recyclables in accordance with the provisions of PA State Act 101.

Those properties in the Borough not receiving municipal recycling collection service including, but not limited to, large apartment and condominium type properties, large commercial and industrial properties, and institutional properties shall establish and maintain their own private recycling programs in accordance with the provisions of this Part and Act 101. All such properties shall submit periodic reports regarding their recycling programs and providing information as requested by the Borough.

Required Recycling Materials include:

Aluminum Cans

Clear, Green, Brown Glass Bottles & Jars (**unbroken** soda/beer bottles, food container)

#1-#7 Plastic Bottles (milk/water/juice/laundry/dish soap/bleaches/fabric softener)

Tin Cans (vegetable/fruit/soup/juice cans)

Newsprint/Magazines/Catalogs/Brochures/Envelopes/Junk Mail

Office/School papers/Construction Paper

Paper Back Books/Phone Books

Clean Paper/Cardboard Egg Cartons

Clean Cardboard Boxes: **No Food Residue, No Plastic Liners** broken down to 2'x2' bundles

Brown Paper Bags
